- Learn the basic elements of a grant proposal and how to make the first approach to funders.

- Data collection for ROID programs will be reviewed and discussion will ensue as to how to make the data more meaningful for the grantees as well as for the NJ DCA.
- Evaluate current programs and assess that objectives are being met for programs and whether changes need to be made.

From NJ TURNPIKE

- Use Exit 8A
- Bear right at exit onto Route 32 West
- Turn left at 2nd traffic light onto Route 130 South
- Turn right at 3rd traffic light onto Dey Road
- Immediately after 2nd light, turn left into Municipal Center parking lot
- Park on the right side – proceed up the stairs = the Recreation Center is directly across from the Municipal Court

From Route 1 North heading South

- Exit at Ridge Road
- Turn Left and cross over Route 1 North and Route 1 South onto Ridge Road South
- Go to 1st traffic light and turn right onto Schalks Crossing (not Corner) Road.
- Go straight 2.2 miles, turn left at the 5th light onto Plainsboro Road
- Plainsboro Municipal Complex will be on your right.
- Park on the right side – proceed up the stairs – the Recreation Center is directly across from the Municipal Court

From Route South heading North

- Turn right onto Plainsboro Road
- Go straight for several miles – the Plainsboro Township Complex will be on the right.
- Park on the right side – proceed up the stairs – the Recreation Center is directly across from the Municipal Court

From Route 130

- Exit onto Dey Road
- Turn left coming from the West
- Turn right coming from the East
- After 2nd traffic light, bear to the left and make a left into the Municipal Center parking lot
- Park on the right side – proceed up the stairs – the Recreation Center is directly across from the Municipal Court
